- ▶ Services tailored specifically for women include group, individual and family counseling, substance abuse education, life skills, relapse prevention, stress management and case management.
- ▶ Family involvement.
- ▶ Length of stay: 90 – 180 days.
- ▶ Serves 13 residential / 22 day treatment women.

Residential treatment program for women and their children in Salt Lake City.

- ▶ Parents and children receive individualized treatment services.
- ▶ Services include: assessment, individual, group and family counseling, substance abuse education, life skills, relapse prevention, parenting education, case management and referral to other services as needed.
- ▶ Children's services meet the special needs of high – risk children of substance abusing parents.
- ▶ Length of stay: 90 – 180 days.
- ▶ Serves 7 mothers, 11 children (birth to 8 years).

Hope Center for Children

- ▶ Services include: assessment, case management, group skills development in the areas of social, physical and emotional growth.

- ▶ Serves 18 men / 14 transitional beds.

- ▶ Services include: assessment, group, individual and family counseling, substance abuse education, life skills, relapse prevention and aftercare services.
- ▶ Therapeutic children's program.
- ▶ Vocational training: computer skills and other skills.
- ▶ Basic High School education classes aimed at GED.
- ▶ Length of stay: 60 – 90 days for intensive level; up to a year of less intensive service as determined by individual needs.
- ▶ Serves up to 20 clients and their children.
