The attached sealed bid forms and contract shall be completed, signed and returned with your bid. A firm project completion date shall be specified. GRAVEL CRUSHING SPECIFICATIONS

The Juab County Road Department is soliciting sealed bids for gravel crushing services "on-site" at the Mona, UT. Juab County Gravel Pit located immediately West and North of the Mona south bound I-15 Interchange. Crushing shall be "pit run" with no washing or overburden removal.

The final bid price shall be a price per ton and shall include all costs for any and all equipment mobilization including all move-in and move-out costs, all labor, all machinery time and any and all other costs directly or indirectly related to the complete and finished crushing of gravel located on-site at the Juab County, Mona, UT., Gravel Pit.

Successful Bidder shall be responsible to notify MSHAW of start of operations and to strictly comply with all MSHAW safety standards, regulations and laws. Upon completion of project, Gravel Pit Banks shall be sloped at a 33% (3 to 1) finished grade and Gravel Pit floor shall remain level at finished grade.

Bidders shall specify a per ton price complete for each of the following quantities. Juab County will determine the tonnage crushed by the price per ton. Upon project completion, and engineering company will survey the tonnage to determine final tons paid to contractor.

When mining product to be crushed, all rocks 18 inches in diameter and below will be crushed. Larger rocks shall be stacked in a spoils pile on-site.

The time frame to accomplish this crushing is flexible between the bid acceptance date and March 31st, 2019.

DELIVERY: Time of project completion will be considered in determining successful bidder. Please separately specify preferred time frames for accomplishing gravel crushing. Failure to complete the crushing by March 31st, 2019 shall result in a penalty to the successful bidder.
