

# **JRDA LANDFILL RULES**

## **SOLID WASTE MUST BE SEPARATED!**

***Notice:* HOUSEHOLD, CONSTRUCTION *and* DEMOLITION, *and* YARD WASTE (Green Waste) MUST BE SEPARATED *PRIOR TO DUMPING!*  
NO HAZARDOUS WASTE ACCEPTED!**

## **DUMP ONLY IN DESIGNATED DUMPING AREAS!**

( County Ordinance prohibits solid waste disposal in any area of the county except in an approved landfill )

**DUMPING ON NON-DESIGNATED PUBLIC OR PRIVATE LAND OR  
OUTSIDE THE LANDFILL GATE IS ILLEGAL AND STRICTLY PROHIBITED!**

**VIOLATORS WILL BE PROSECUTED TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT OF THE LAW!**

**"NO DISCHARGING OF FIREARMS ALLOWED IN DESIGNATED LANDFILL AREAS!"**

## **OPERATING HOURS**

**Monday through Friday - 9:00 am to 5:30 pm (year around)**

**Saturdays - 8:00 am to 4:00 pm**

***CLOSED:* Sundays and Holidays**

**NOTE: GATES ARE LOCKED DURING NON OPERATING HOURS - Do NOT Dump Outside the Gates!**

## **LANDFILL FEES**

In order to dispose of waste at the landfill, you must be a monthly fee paying customer **OR**  
**purchase a dumping permit** from the Juab County Clerk/Auditor **PRIOR** to dumping!

**\*\*\*[EXCEPTION: A DEAD ANIMAL WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT ADDITIONAL CHARGE]\*\*\***

# CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION WASTE

## **Construction and Demolition Waste includes:**

- Solid Waste from building materials, packaging, and rubble resulting from construction, remodeling, repair, and demolition operations on pavements, houses, commercial buildings, and other structures.
- Such waste may include: bricks, concrete, other masonry materials, soil, asphalt, rock, **untreated lumber**, pallets, crates, yard waste (if a separate burn area has not been established), rebar, flooring, carpet and pad (only if the result of a remodel or demolition), sheet rock, roofing, insulation, windows, siding and gutters.
- Steel and other metals only if they are generated by Construction and Demolition operations.
- Empty Cans, buckets or tubes holding less than 10% construction products such as paints, adhesives, solvents or sealers.

## **Construction and Demolition Waste DOES NOT INCLUDE:**

- Household Waste or Green Waste.
- Furniture of any kind including couches, chairs, bed frames, bed springs, box springs, mattresses, headboards, footboards, drawers and tables.
- Electronic appliances such as T.V.'s, Radios, Stereos, Computers, VCR's, etc..
- Treated Lumber **unless** it is the result of demolition. Railroad Ties are not considered Construction and Demolition Waste.
- Cardboard or other packaging that is **not** the direct result of Construction and Demolition.
- Asbestos, contaminated soils or tanks resulting from remediation or clean-up at any release or spill.
- Waste paints, solvents, sealers, adhesives, acids, oils, fuels or similar hazardous or potentially hazardous materials.
- Old Vehicles, Trailers, Equipment or Batteries.
- Water Heaters **unless** the direct result of a demolition and cannot reasonably be separated.
- Metal that is not a product of construction or demolition. Examples include: water heaters, pipe, appliances, bicycles, metal in general, unless stored in a recyclable area.
- Manufacturing Waste Materials e.g.; foams, waste rubber, metals, plastics, electronic components, etc..
- Empty Cans, buckets or tubes holding less than 10% construction products such as paints, adhesives, solvents or sealers or other hazardous materials.

## GREEN WASTE / YARD WASTE

- Green waste **include** organic items such as brush, branches, clippings, leaves, and grass.
- Green waste **do not include** household waste of any kind, processed lumber such as 2 x 4's, pallets, crates and cardboard or Construction and Demolition Waste as defined above

## HOUSEHOLD WASTE

- Household waste **include** all other waste types not identified as Construction & Demolition Waste or as green Waste.
